The events of the past two weeks have shaped concerns – with the increase in positive tests

Additional changes may occur in the next two weeks

Please remember to complete [the survey by Monday, July 6, 2020](#). We've had over 10,000 parents complete the survey; we need another 10-12,000 to complete to get a better picture of your wishes

Based on that feedback, we can better understand your concerns – about isolation or about having a virtual environment

The plan can only evolve based on the feedback that you provide

We heard you loud and clear - that you wanted to make sure you understood the mechanism by which you may make a change to the type of instructional delivery that you think is best for your child, if needed before the start of the year.

LRSD has some latitude there, but we need some additional information from you to help us plan

It's a holiday – so please be sure to stay safe. Don't lose sight of the important things to keep you safe. Take care of yourself and take care of your family - if you do that, you are also taking care of others
