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Pre-K Families,

Little Rock School District was approved by the state to provide alternate home learning activities for up to 6 Alternative Method of Instruction (AMI) days. By using the home learning activities when schools are closed, we do not have to make up the school days.

### **The LRSD Pre-K Home Learning Activities**

- Provides real activities and ideas to talk, play, and learn together to encourage learning at home even when there is no school due to inclement weather (but you can use these ideas anytime).
- Pre-K does not use worksheets so the packet does not contain any work pages.
- When returning to school, children will be asked to share what they did at home, but there are no papers or work that need to be returned.

### **What to do on Inclement Weather Days**

Just like at school, AMI days, pre-k students should have:

- Free play time (two or more hours)
- Outdoor play time (at school they have one hour per day, weather permitting)
- Breakfast, Lunch, and Snack
- Rest time (about one hour)

In addition, please complete the number of activities to correspond with the number of days absent.
