Record score on the student page after review.

May have letters that are not in the first name Random letters Letter-like forms Scribbles Pictures May be scattered around paper (does not look like a word) No attempt	May have <u>one</u> or <u>two</u> of the letters in the first name in any order May not include all letters in first name Letters may be out of sequence/order (Bsty for Betsy) Letter forms may be reversed, upside down, or written right to left	Has <u>all</u> or <u>most</u> of the letters in the first name (more than half) May include a mixture of upper- and lower-case letters Written Left to Right in the correct order May have reversed/transversed letters if they <u>do not</u> result in another letter (i.e., M/W, b/d, p/q)	First name is spelled correctly (Must have ALL letters in first name) Written left to right in the correct order Names may include any mixture of upper- and lower-case letters Letters cannot look like another letter (i.e. lower case n may look like an h or r depending on formation)	First and last names are spelled correctly Names include correct upper- and lower-case letters Must have a space between first and last name Both names must be written left to right in correct order

If child writes "BeTSy James" – Score 4.

If child writes "bTY" – Score 3.

If child writes "BstY" – Score 2.

Make note of the order the letters were written:

L i s a Which means the L was written first, followed by the s, then i, then a. = Score 2

If written in random order, but the end result looks like LISA or Lisa – Score 2

If Written Left to right:



Lsa – Score 3

If Written Right to left:

L i s a – score 2
 4 3 2 1
